Project Milestones

May 2009 Act 2009-788 authorizes SBVA/ADVA to establish the first State Veterans' Cemetery.

October 2010 USDVA offers ADVA grant opportunity.

January 2011 ADVA announces Walcott Adams Verneuille Architects (Fairhope) as A/E for project.

April 2011 SBVA names cemetery "Alabama State Veterans Memorial Cemetery at Spanish Fort."

May 2011 ADVA gains full ownership of site.

August 2011 USDVA awarded ADVA \$7,015,564 grant.

September 2011 ADVA announces White-Spunner Construction, Inc. (Mobile) as construction contractor.

October 2011 Groundbreaking ceremony.

Spring 2013 Projected completion.
